- △ Picture Post Cards

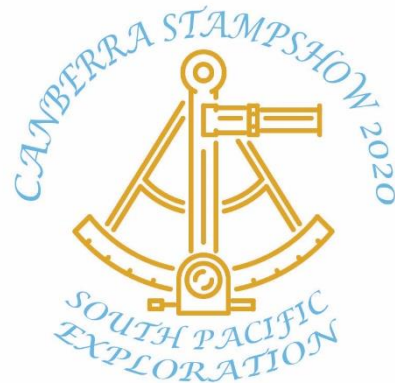
There will be a full range of State exhibition classes as well.

### PACIFIC CHALLENGE

The Philatelic Society of Canberra will be commemorating the 250th anniversary of Captain Cook reaching the east coast of Australia in 2020 with a special prize for the best South Pacific related exhibit. We look forward to the many and varied collections that will be exhibited associated with the South Pacific

The 250<sup>th</sup> anniversary of Captain James Cook's visit to the east coast of Australia occurs in 2020. To mark this anniversary the Philatelic Society of Canberra will provide a special prize for the best South Pacific-related exhibit in any of the classes offered by the Exhibition.

## VENUE

The Stampshow will be held on the first floor of the Hellenic Club of Canberra, Matilda Street, Woden. This has been the venue for the previous nine Canberra Stampshows. Free parking is available on Saturday and Sunday. There are several cafes/restaurants in the building. The Hellenic Club is also next to the Woden Shopping Centre.



## ENTRIES AND FRAMES

**The closing date for entries is Friday 30 November 2019.**

It is important to note that to minimize the cost of frame transport, only one container of frames will be used in Canberra. This limits the total number of frames available to 330, so get your entries in early.

The Canberra Stampshow 2020 is also the last chance to qualify for national exhibition at Melbourne FIAP to be held in February 2021. Don't miss out.

While there are no interstate Commissioners, we will attempt to identify people coming to the exhibition who may be able to carry exhibits coming from interstate.

Make sure you read the Prospectus carefully to ensure your exhibits are delivered safely and in time:

- △ Hand delivered entries must be received in the Bin Room by 10 am 12 March 2020.
- △ New Zealand entries must be delivered and returned by the New Zealand Commissioner.
- △ Entries sent by mail must be in the hands of the Exhibition Coordinator not earlier than 2 March 2020 and not later than 9 March 2020.
- △ All literature entries must be received by the Committee by 15 January 2018.

With New Zealand 2020 immediately after the Canberra Stampshow, consideration is being given to how exhibits may be transported immediately to New Zealand after the Stampshow. More on this in the next Bulletin.

## DEALERS

We are expecting to have approximately 30 local, national and overseas dealers at the exhibition. Come along and meet up with favourite dealers.

A number of international dealers use this exhibition to start or finish a tour of Australia but this time the New Zealand exhibition is being held in the week immediately after the Canberra Stampshow.

The names of dealers will be placed on the Philatelic Society of Canberra and APF web sites when they are confirmed.

There will be a range of prizes to be awarded however the Committee is seeking prize contributions from Philatelic organizations or individuals to support and encourage exhibitors. ## ACCOMPANYING VISITORS

The timing of the Canberra Stampshow 2020 coincides with a range of events held in Canberra before, during and after the Stampshow.

While it is not the Canberra Day long weekend, you will have the opportunity to participate in the Canberra Enlighten Festival when the city is a hive of activity. This Festival is held over the first 17 days in March.

Around the Parliamentary Triangle the national icon buildings will be ablaze for 11 nights with fantastic moving images (not limited to tall buildings in streets as in some cities!). Wander around for free. There are also ticketed events.

The Canberra Balloon Spectacular is also held on the edge of Lake Burley Griffin for those of you who like cool early morning walks as well as Lights! Canberra! Action!, Symphony in the Park, and Skyfire.
