JURY REPORT

Canberra Stampshow 2020 is the 21st Biannual Exhibition organised by the Philatelic Society of Canberra. The exhibition offered National Classes including Postal History, Aerophilately, Postal Stationery, Revenues, Literature, Youth and Picture Post Cards as well as State Level Classes. There is also a Pacific Challenge to mark the 250th anniversary of Captain James Cook's visit to the east coast of Australia with a special prize for the best South Pacific-related exhibit.

There were 74 entries including 61 National level exhibits and 13 state-level entries. Three exhibits were 'no-shows'.

The Jury noted the high quality of the exhibits with Large Gold, Gold, Large Vermeil, Vermeil. Large Silver, Silver medals awarded.

The Jury team comprised 15 jurors, including an accord judge Paul McTaggart (New Zealand) and one apprentice. I would like to thank all members of the Jury for the professional conduct of their work and for their collaborative approach including Glen Stafford as Secretary, Johnna Stafford as Assistant Secretary and for her help with Exhibition Aide along with Linda Weldon and Lyn Hayes.
