COMMITTEE WELCOME

Welcome to this, the first Bulletin for the Canberra Stampshow 2022, the 22nd Biennial National Philatelic Convention staged by the Philatelic Society of Canberra Inc., who will, in 2022, celebrate its 90th Anniversary.

Canberra Stampshow 2022 is a half National Exhibition with both National and State-level classes.

Theme

Having witnessed the extraordinary resilience and capacity of Australians to recover from the various natural disasters, together with the COVID 19 pandemic, that have impacted the Country in the past two years, the Stampshow Committee were as one, in their choice of ***Resilience & Recovery*** as the theme for the Canberra Stampshow 2022.

2022 also marks the 80th anniversary of some of Australia's greatest challenges which occurred during World War II. It will also mark the 70th anniversary of the reign of Her Majesty, Queen Elizabeth II, who played an important role in the resilience and recovery in her Realms especially during and after WWII.

Classes

The Canberra Stampshow 2022 is offering entry to the following national classes:

Additionally, there will be a full range of State exhibition classes.

Exhibition dates

The Canberra Stampshow 2022, will be held from Friday 18 March through to Sunday 20 March. Whilst this is NOT the Canberra Day long weekend, it is generally a time of multiple events in Canberra, albeit in recent times they have been adversely impacted as a result of the Covid 19 pandemic.

Hopefully, as we enter 2022, Australia will have progressed closer to returning to a more normal operating environment.

RESILIENCE & RECOVERY CHALLENGE

The Philatelic Society of Canberra will provide a special prize for the best exhibit in any of the classes offered by the Exhibition, related to the theme ***Resilience & Recovery*** (worldwide), whether relating to the impact of a natural disaster, war or a pandemic.

We look forward to the many and varied collections that will undoubtedly be exhibited, associated with what we believe will be, a very popular theme with exhibitors.

MELBOURNE 2022 QUALIFYING SECOND CHANCE CHALLENGE

Exhibitors who exhibit at Newcastle 2021 or Palmerston North 2021, and who fail to qualify for Melbourne 2022, receiving a Large Silver or Silver Award, have a second chance to qualify for Melbourne, by entering the 2nd Chance classes in Division 3.

The Canberra Stampshow 2022, is also the last chance to qualify for the national exhibition at Melbourne FIAP to be held in September 2022. The Philatelic Society of Canberra will provide a special prize for the best exhibit which qualifies for Melbourne 2022 and which has not previously qualified.

The Prospectus is available now and it would be wise not to delay submitting your entry.

VENUE



For the first time, The Canberra Stampshow will be held at *Thoroughbred Park*, Randwick Road, LYNEHAM, in the fully enclosed, ground floor Betting Auditorium.

The venue is approximately 15 mins north of the Canberra City Centre, near Exhibition Park and Canberra's new Light Rail Track.

The facility is spacious with extensive on-site parking, a 10-minute walk to the new light rail station, and an eight-minute drive to the popular Dickson Restaurant Precinct and Northbourne Avenue accommodation facilities that can also be reached by the light rail service.

There is an on-site café from which to obtain food and refreshments during the event.

ENTRIES AND FRAMES

The closing date for entries is Friday 30 November 2021.

The total number of frames available will be limited to 320.

DELIVERY OF EXHIBITS

Given the continuing issue with the Covid 19 pandemic, the only overseas Commissioner likely to be appointed for the Show, will be from New Zealand, with whom Australia has established a travel bubble. In the event of this arrangement being confirmed, all New Zealand entries will be required to be processed through the NZ Commissioner, [Karen Jeffrey Email: karenjanejeffrey@outlook.com](mailto:karenjanejeffrey@outlook.com). In the event that this situation changes, alternative arrangements are provided for within the Prospectus.

While there are no formal state commissioners for a Half National Exhibition, Canberra 2022 will make arrangements with members of the Jury and other attendees for the conveyance and return of interstate exhibits where exhibitors are not attending the show in person. You will be advised the appropriate person to contact when the exhibition frame envelope cover sheets are sent out.

Make sure you read the Prospectus carefully to ensure your exhibits are delivered safely and in time:

- Δ Hand delivered entries must be received in the Bin Room by 10 am 17 March 2022.
- Δ New Zealand entries must be delivered and returned by the New Zealand Commissioner.
- Δ Entries sent by mail must be in the hands of the Exhibition Coordinator not earlier than 8 March 2022 and not later than 15 March 2022.
- Δ All literature entries must be received by the Committee by 19 January 2022.

DEALERS

We are anticipating participation of approximately 20 local, national, and overseas dealers at the exhibition. Final numbers will of course depend on any travel restrictions applicable at the time.

The names of dealers will be placed on the Philatelic Society of Canberra and APF web sites once confirmed.

PRIZES

There will be a range of prizes to be awarded. However, the Committee is seeking prize contributions from Philatelic organizations or individuals to support and encourage exhibitors.
