SPECIAL CHALLENGES FOR EXHIBITORS



The Fifth Biennial Picture Postcard Challenge to be held as part of Canberra Stamp Show 2024.

The Challenge involves Australian States, Territories, New Zealand or any affiliated Club/Society entering a team. Team entries need to contain four picture postcard exhibits 2 x multi-frame (5 frames or more) and 2 x 1-frame competing to win the Perpetual Trophy.

Universal Postal Union (UPU) 150th Anniversary Challenge

Exhibitors are encouraged to provide exhibits which highlight the UPU and its contribution to the post over the last 150 years.

The Exhibition will provide a major prize for the best exhibit with a UPU connection. Exhibits may be in any national class. Since its establishment on 9 October 1874, the UPU has had an enormous effect on worldwide philately and we are celebrating this in 2024.

50 Years-On Challenge - the 1970s

In Australia it was the era of metric stamps, prime ministers, marine life and gemstones.

The Exhibition will provide a prize for the best exhibit relating in some way to the 1970s. The winner can come from any Division/class.

Stamp Club Challenge

Philatelic Societies and Stamp Cubs are encouraged to enter a 'club challenge'. This can be done by entering three National level exhibits in Division 2.

The exhibits may be in any class except Youth and Literature and comprise any number of frames. The winning club/society will be awarded a plaque. Entries must be confirmed as part of the Challenge by the relevant club and indicate that they are part of the Challenge on the on-line entry form.

Travel directions to Thoroughbred Park Canberra.

From Sydney - Approach Canberra on the Federal Hwy. Turn right at Flemington Rd

and continue for 800m. Turn left on Randwick Rd and entry to Thoroughbred Park is 200 metres on your left.

<u>From Yass / Melbourne / Barton Hwy Approach</u>. Turn left on Randwick Rd and entry to Thoroughbred Park is 1km along on your right.

<u>From Canberra Northbourne avenue</u> - Drive along Northbourne avenue and turn left at Flemington Rd. Continue for 800m. Turn left on Randwick Rd and entry to Thoroughbred Park is 200 metres on your left.

Thoroughbred Park is accessible by Canberra's light rail & bus service.
