J.H. Smyth & Co

J.H. Smyth signed letter to recalcitrant client, Jun 13 1904

" Sic Fortis Struria Crebit," J. H. SMYTH & CO., Late of 14 Hunter Street, 88 KING STREET, SYDNEY, N.S.W. ESTABLISHED 1800 Dealers in Australasian and Foreign Postage Stamps Albums, and all Collectors' Requisites. Australasia; abroad 1/- extra Sole Australian Agents for Stanley Gibbons' Publications. Sydney, 18th June 1904. Mesers Morrison, Dear Sirs:-About two months ago you wrote asking us to send you some barrented stamps on approval. On the 35th April we sent you a book of stamps on approval, valge 281 - 8 - 0; and, in our letter, said that we should not sold to be returned to us in about a week or ten days time. Hot having received the book up till the 17th ult.; we wrote asking you to let us have it back by an early post. As we did not receive any reply to that letter we wrote you again on the 3rd June asking you to let us have it back by return of post, but, up to the present, have not had a reply to any of these letters. This is not good business, and we cannot understand why you do not write and explain your reason for not returning the book. If you had given us any explanation regarding the matter we would have been quite satisfied, and it seems to us rather strange that you should keep the book so long seeing that you only asked to see some baureated stamps. Of course if you have decided to keep the book entirely, well and good, but you might write and say so. As to the stamps and packets sent you on sale or return we are not bothering about them at all, but we have a customor waiting to see some of the stamps in the other book, if you do not keep them, and the oustom in our business is for books of that kind to be returned at the time requested. We like to give our oustomers ample opportunity of making their selection, but, in the absence of information from you, we do not know what to think. Kindly let us hear from you by return of post and oblige.

<u>From Sydney</u> - Approach Canberra on the Federal Hwy. Turn right at Flemington Rd

and continue for 800m. Turn left on Randwick Rd and entry to Thoroughbred Park is 200 metres on your left.

<u>From Yass / Melbourne / Barton Hwy Approach</u>. Turn left on Randwick Rd and entry to Thoroughbred Park is 1km along on your right.

<u>From Canberra Northbourne avenue</u> - Drive along Northbourne avenue and turn left at Flemington Rd. Continue for 800m. Turn left on Randwick Rd and entry to Thoroughbred Park is 200 metres on your left.

Thoroughbred Park is accessible by Canberra's light rail & bus service.
